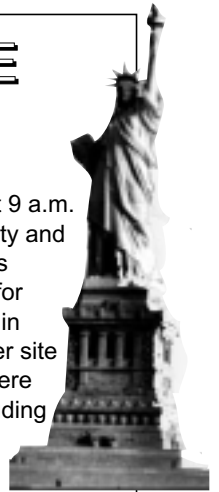


SPRING/SUMMER 2009 BUS TRIP SCHEDULE

WEDNESDAY, MARCH 4 PHILADELPHIA FLOWER SHOW

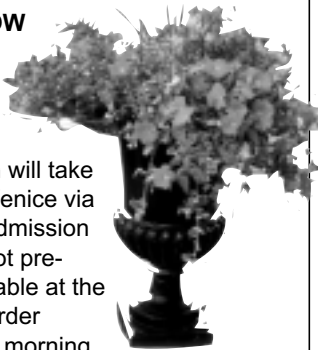
The bus will leave the Milford Grand Union parking lot at 8 a.m. for the world's largest indoor flower show. The theme for this year's event is Bella Italia, which will take us from Rome to Tuscany and Venice via beautiful horticultural exhibits. Admission to the show is \$24, and we do not pre-purchase tickets. They are available at the door. However, if you wish to order advance tickets, they are \$22. A morning snack will be served on the trip down. Lunch will be on your own. There are many restaurants nearby and within the Convention Center itself. There will be only one bus, so please book early so you are not disappointed. Cost for transportation only is \$35. In case of inclement weather such as a major snowstorm, the bus may be cancelled and postponed to Friday, March 6.

WEDNESDAY, APRIL 22 NEW YORK CITY "ON YOUR OWN"

The bus will leave the Milford Grand Union parking lot at 8 a.m. Join us for a day in the city to do as you wish. For those interested in theater tickets, the Duffy Square half-price ticket booth has re-opened in the center of Broadway and is now accepting credit cards as well as cash. The bus will leave the city at 5:30 p.m. from the same area as the drop-off. Expected arrival time back in Milford is about 7:45 p.m. Cost for transportation and driver's tip is \$30.

TUESDAY, MAY 19

STATUE OF LIBERTY AND ELLIS ISLAND

The bus will leave the Grand Union parking lot at 9 a.m. Join us for an inspiring trip to the Statue of Liberty and Ellis Island. Perhaps you may find your ancestors names on the Wall of Immigrants. We will leave for these historic landmarks from Liberty State Park in NJ, and you will have your choice of visiting either site on your own time. Lunch will be on your own. There will be only one bus. Cost for this trip is \$38 including admission, transportation and driver's tip.

TUESDAY, JUNE 9

HUNTERDON HILLS PLAYHOUSE & LUNCH

The bus will leave the Grand Union parking lot at 9 a.m. for Hunterdon Hills Playhouse in NJ to see *Over the River and through the Woods*, a great comedy about an Italian-American family by Joe DiPietro, the author of *I Love You, You're Perfect, Now Change*. The story is about Nick, a 29-year-old Manhattan bachelor, whose parents retire to Florida leaving him in charge of his two sets of grandparents who drive him crazy with their non-stop eating and unending criticism of his unmarried status. Trip includes a served lunch with a choice of five entrees, all-you-can-eat homemade dessert cart and full service cocktail bar. The playhouse features tiered seating and state-of-the-art sound system. All this for the unbeatable price of \$75. Book early; there will only be one bus.

WEDNESDAY, THURSDAY, FRIDAY JULY 1, 2, 3 — TRIP TO BOSTON

See Boston and leave the driving to us! The bus will leave the Sunshine Station at 8 a.m. On our first day, we will visit the Isabella Stuart Gardner Museum — a must-see if you are in the Boston area. We will then check into our hotel, the Holiday Inn and Conference Center in Dedham, where we will have time to swim or just relax and meet before going to dinner nearby. Included in the trip is the famous sight-seeing Duck Tour in an amphibious landing vehicle, visits to Faneuil Hall and Quincy Market, a tour of the waterfront area and admission to the New England Aquarium. Betty Toscano, our wonderful guide from the Cape Cod trip, will guide us around the city on the second day. Please call early if you are interested in this trip. A deposit of \$100 per person is due by March 15, with the balance due by May 15. Cost is \$385 per person/triple; \$400 per person/double; \$520 single.

Join us for a Sunday in New York City. We will go to the Metropolitan Museum of Art, but you are free to go anywhere else. We will leave the Grand Union at 9 a.m. and depart the city at 4:30 p.m. Here's a chance to include children or grandchildren in a wonderful experience at a special New York museum. Cost for the day is \$30 for adults; \$20 for children under 18. Admission to the Met is not included. They have a voluntary donation policy.
