### WEDNESDAY, MARCH 9

#### PHILADELPHIA FLOWER SHOW & ART MUSEUM

The bus will leave the Milford Grand Union (Milford Farms) parking lot at 8 a.m. for the Philadelphia Flower Show. There will be a dual drop off for those wishing to go to the Philadelphia Art Museum, and they will be picked up there on the return trip home. The theme for this year’s flower show is “Paris in Springtime.”

Coincidentally, the Art Museum is having a special exhibit titled “Paris Through the Window” featuring works by Marc Chagall and his circle. The entry fee for the Flower Show is \$25. You may leave the Convention Center at any time, just remember to have your hand stamped. There are many restaurants for lunch within a block or two, and there is always the Reading Terminal Market to tease your taste buds and shopping skills.

The bus will leave the Convention Center at 4:30 p.m. and pick-up at the nearby Art Museum at 4:45.

### WEDNESDAY, MAY 25

#### CULINARY INSTITUTE AND MILLS MANSION

The bus will leave the Milford Grand Union (Milford Farms) parking lot at 8:30 a.m. for Hyde Park, NY. At 10:15, we will enjoy a student-led guided tour of the historic Culinary Institute of America. Once a Jesuit Seminary, the building now houses a world-renowned cooking school. At 11:30, we will lunch in the charming St. Andrew’s Café which offers the freshest locally grown ingredients. After lunch, we will have time to browse their fabulous gift shop. A mansion we have NOT yet visited is scheduled for the afternoon. The Mills Mansion in Staatsburg is a 25-room, Greek Revival home built by Morgan Lewis in 1832. Ruth Mills, the wife of philanthropist Ogden Mills, inherited it and, after a major renovation in 1896, it was transformed into a 65-room, Beaux-Arts mansion. The rooms are elaborately furnished with fine oriental rugs and silks and contain a collection of art objects from Europe, Ancient Greece and the Far East.

#### FINGER LAKES & WINERY TOUR

Enjoy the scenery of the Finger Lakes on a relaxing three-day vacation.
